A Quick Hello from Communications


Hello Wizards families!

IMPORTANT NOTICE: League Moved to Tiered Play

As we gear up for the upcoming season, we want to share that our league (GELC) **has transitioning to a tiered system**. Because of this shift, we strongly encourage all players (new and returning) to come out to our preseason events and evaluations.

Tiering Format:

- **U7 and U9:** Not tiered. Clubs must maintain team parity within the division.
- **U11, U13, U15:** Tiered into three levels – A, B, and C.
- **U17:** Tiered into two levels – A and B.
- **Female Lacrosse:** Not tiered. Will be organized as parity-based divisions.

Your participation in evaluations helps us accurately assess skills, interest, and places players where they'll succeed and grow.



EVALUATIONS 101

LET THE SORTING HAT WORK ITS MAGIC (BECAUSE WE'RE **WIZARDS**... GET IT?)




EVALUATIONS & TEAM PLACEMENT

Evaluations will take place in March and are used to help create balanced teams where players can develop and succeed.

Evaluations are designed to:

- Place players in the **appropriate tier** for skill development
- Create **balanced teams**
- Support long-term athlete development
- Ensure players have a positive + competitive season

Evaluations are not tryouts in the “cut” sense. We aim to place every registered player on a team.



How the Tiering System Works



Tier placement is about **player developmental fit**, NOT labels. Players can move between tiers year-to-year.

A – Advanced / Highly Competitive

- Strong lacrosse fundamentals
- Game awareness and decision-making
- Faster pace of play

B – Intermediate / Growing Competitive

- Solid fundamentals with room to grow
- Learning positional play and consistency

C – Developmental / Foundational

- Newer players or those building core skills
- Focus on confidence, basics, and enjoyment

How Age Divisions Are Evaluated (High-Level)

U7 / U9


- Focus on fundamentals and enthusiasm
- Effort, coordination, and willingness to participate matter most

U11 / U13

- Balance of skills and game understanding
- Evaluators look at positional awareness and consistency
- Tier placement becomes more defined

U15 / U17

- Strong emphasis on game IQ, pace, and decision-making
- Physical readiness and competitiveness considered
- Tier placement aligns with league competition levels



EVALUATIONS 101

FAIR, STRUCTURED, **PLAYER-FIRST**. THIS IS WHERE CHAMPS ARE BUILT



EVALUATION STRUCTURE

Most age groups follow a station-based evaluation format:

1. Check-In & Warm-Up
2. Skill Stations
3. Small-Area Games or Scrimmage
4. Coach Review & Scoring



IMPORTANT

A Few Notes for Families during Evaluations

- One evaluation does not define a player
- **Coaches value effort and attitude as much as raw skill**
- Growth and improvement happen quickly, especially in younger divisions
- Movement between tiers can happen season to season

1 Check-In & Warm-Up



Players begin by checking in with their age group and getting settled into the space.

This portion includes:

- Age-group check-in
- A light, guided warm-up to reduce nerves and get bodies moving
- Assignment of jerseys or pinnies (when used)

Our goal here is simple: help players feel comfortable, confident, and ready to play.

2 Drill Stations

Players rotate through a series of stations that assess core lacrosse skills in a structured, supportive way. Stations may include:

- Passing & catching
- Cradling & ball control
- Shooting
- Footwork & agility
- Defensive positioning (age-appropriate)



Evaluators are looking at more than just outcomes. We focus on:

- Technique and fundamentals
- Effort and engagement
- Coachability and willingness to learn
- Overall game awareness

This approach allows players with different experience levels to be evaluated fairly.

3 Game or Scrimmage

Each session includes short, controlled game play. These small-area games or scrimmages allow coaches to observe:

- Decision-making under pressure
- Team play and communication
- Movement without the ball
- Hustle, effort, and awareness



This portion helps evaluators see how players apply their skills in game situations.

4 Coach Review & Scoring

After each evaluation session:

- Coaches and evaluators score players using a standardized evaluation rubric
- Multiple evaluators are involved to help reduce bias
- Scores are reviewed collectively

Final team placement decisions are made with care, collaboration, and the goal of creating balanced teams that support player development.

Goaltenders Special Registration Incentive



50% Fee Refund for Goaltenders

We are actively recruiting goalies in every age division for the upcoming season.

To support this important position, registered goaltenders are eligible to receive a 50% refund on their registration fees for the season.

Goaltenders registered for the 2026 lacrosse season will be eligible for a 50% registration fee discount.

Due to the limited number of teams, this discount will be **applied only after teams have been finalized.**



Eligible goaltenders will be required to sign a commitment agreement prior to receiving the discount.

NOTE: DISCOUNT APPLIES ONLY TO THE U11-U17 DIVISIONS, AS THESE AGE DIVISIONS HAVE DESIGNATED GOALTENDER POSITIONS.

GROWING THE FEMALE GAME

Committed to Opportunity + Division Development

Female lacrosse continues to be one of the fastest-growing areas of our club, and last season marked an exciting step forward. Across the GELC, clubs saw strong growth in female participation, **highlighting the increasing interest and enthusiasm** for the game at every age level.

As we rev up for the 2026 season, **our focus remains on creating the best possible playing experience for female athletes.** That means supporting fair team sizes, positive team environments, and meaningful player development, while ensuring that every athlete who wants to play has a pathway to do so.

To support this growth responsibly, we will be following the same successful registration approach used last season. For all Female Divisions, registration will move to a waitlist once a team reaches 18 runners and 1 goalie. **This allows the club to maintain balanced rosters and monitor interest closely.**

Our Registrar is actively managing the waitlist throughout the registration term. When the waitlist reaches 12 runners and 1 goalie, families will be contacted and the process of forming an additional team will begin. If waitlist numbers do not reach the threshold required to form a second team, players will have the option to transfer to another Female team within the GELC, **ensuring every athlete has an opportunity to play.**




QUESTIONS? We're here to help!


