## IMPORTANT NOTICE: League Moving to Tiered Play

As we prepare for the upcoming season, we want to share that our league (GELC) is **transitioning to a tiered system**. Because of this shift, we strongly encourage all players (new and returning) to come out to our preseason events and evaluations.

Tiering Format:

- **U7 and U9:** Not tiered. Clubs must maintain team parity within the division.
- **U11, U13, U15:** Tiered into three levels – A, B, and C.
- **U17:** Tiered into two levels – A and B.
- **Female Lacrosse:** Not tiered. Will be organized as parity-based divisions.

**Your participation in evaluations helps us** accurately assess skills, interest, and places players where they'll succeed and grow.

## Goalies Wanted at Every Age Group

## Goaltenders Special Registration Incentive



### 50% Fee Refund for Goaltenders

We are actively recruiting goalies in every age division for the upcoming season.

To support this important position, registered goaltenders are eligible to receive a 50% refund on their registration fees for the season.

**Goaltenders registered for the 2026 lacrosse season will be eligible for a 50% registration fee discount.**

Due to the limited number of teams, this discount will be **applied only after teams have been finalized.**



Eligible goaltenders will be required to sign a commitment agreement prior to receiving the discount.

***NOTE: DISCOUNT APPLIES ONLY TO THE U11-U17 DIVISIONS, AS THESE AGE DIVISIONS HAVE DESIGNATED GOALTENDER POSITIONS.***

## GROWING THE FEMALE GAME

**Committed to Opportunity + Division Development**

Female lacrosse continues to be one of the fastest-growing areas of our club, and last season marked an exciting step forward. Across the GELC, clubs saw strong growth in female participation, **highlighting the increasing interest and enthusiasm** for the game at every age level.

As we prepare for the 2026 season, **our focus remains on creating the best possible playing experience for female athletes.** That means supporting fair team sizes, positive team environments, and meaningful player development, while ensuring that every athlete who wants to play has a pathway to do so.

To support this growth responsibly, we will be following the same successful registration approach used last season. For all Female Divisions, registration will move to a waitlist once a team reaches 18 runners and 1 goalie. **This allows the club to maintain balanced rosters and monitor interest closely.**

Our Registrar is actively managing the waitlist throughout the registration term. When the waitlist reaches 12 runners and 1 goalie, families will be contacted and the process of forming an additional team will begin. If waitlist numbers do not reach the threshold required to form a second team, players will have the option to transfer to another Female team within the GELC, **ensuring every athlete has an opportunity to play.**

## WHAT TO EXPECT FROM EVALUATIONS

Evaluations will take place in March and are used to help our club create balanced teams where players can develop and succeed.

A few important things to know:

- Evaluations are **not tryouts** — everyone who registers will play
- Players are assessed on effort, fundamentals, and game awareness
- The goal is fair placement and positive development

More detailed evaluation schedules and information will be shared closer to March.

## GETTING READY FOR THE SEASON

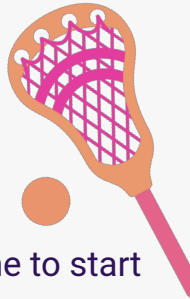
### Simple Preseason Tips

January and February are a great time to start easing back into lacrosse with no pressure. Some easy ways players can prepare:

**Wall Ball & Stick Skills:** Spending just a few minutes a day throwing and catching against a wall helps improve hand-eye coordination, stick control, and confidence with the ball.

**Stick Handling at Home:** Cradling, switching hands, and carrying the ball around the house or driveway builds familiarity with the stick. These simple movements help players feel more natural once they're back on the floor.

**Stay Active Through Other Sports:** Hockey, basketball, swimming, running. Any activity that keeps players moving helps maintain fitness, agility, and endurance. Multi-sport athletes often transition into lacrosse smoothly.



## EQUIPMENT CHECK

### Beat The Rush

Now is a great time to:

- Check stick length and pocket condition
- Make sure helmets & pads still fit
- Replace worn or broken equipment

If your player is new to lacrosse or trying goalie for the first time, **we are happy to offer equipment guidance** and support ahead of evaluations.

This season, she earned a spot on the "A" team, becoming **the only girl on the North Lacrosse team**, a testament to her skill, confidence, and determination. Known for her persistence and tenacity, Abigail has made a name for herself among teammates, opponents, and coaches alike. Her strong hand-eye coordination, exceptional stick control, and fearless play have made her a force on the floor. **A true team player**, she leads both on and off the floor: setting up plays, making smart passes, and breaking through the opposition's defense.

Abigail's hard work and love for the game reached a major milestone this past summer when she was **selected to represent Team Alberta at the National Championships in Halifax**. Chosen as one of just 21 players from across the province, she had the opportunity to travel, compete at the highest level, and represent Alberta on the national stage.

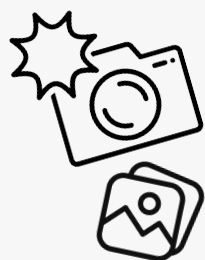


## QUESTIONS? We're here to help!
